#### **Guidelines for Parents**

Parent - teacher co-operation is essential for complete and harmonious development of the student's personality. The process of informal education is set in motion at birth and gains momentum in the school, a centre of formal education. To bring out the best in the child, family influences should aid and supplement school efforts. Both school and home should help the child inculcate in her/him the desirable behaviour patterns, healthy habits and positive attitudes in personal and social life to make her/him a pride of family and an asset to the society. Consent vigilance on the part of the guardians pays rich dividends. Please read the following points in the interest of your ward:

- 1. Co-operative with the school by paying attention to your ward's regularity, punctuality and discipline by taking interest in his/her work.
- 2. Do check the bag of your ward for any circular, worksheet, homework etc. given from the school.
- 3. Parents are not allowed to take the child home unless it is very urgent. In that case either father or mother has to come personally to take the child from the school.

- 4. No. student will be permitted to go home after the Unit Tests and Term Examinations. Therefore parents should not send their ward to appear in the examinations of she/he is unwell.
- 5. Do not give mobile phones or any other valuables things to your child. If the child brings these things, they will be confiscated under all circumstances by the school authorities and disciplinary action will be taken against them.
- 6. Children tend to pick up abusive language/foul wards from different sources without understanding their meaning. We will take requisite measures to counsel and check them at our end also request you to take corrective actions at your end.

#### **Guideline for Students**

- The observance of rules of discipline and good behaviour is essential to student's continuance in the school. The decision of the school authorities is final and binding on all the students in respect of rules/instructions framed for discipline and good behaviour.
- 2. Expected Practice: All students must ensure:
  - a) To be regular and punctual in attending the school. Exemption from compulsory sports, games and P.T. is granted only after certified by the doctor for unfitness. Immaculate turn out in school uniform / house dress with proper hair styles and grooming.
  - b) Presence in classroom at all times while the class is in progress except with the permission (card) of the teachers. Switch off the light and fans before leaving the class room. Do not crowd around in the corridors, near washrooms, water dispensers and sports ground etc.
  - c) Move from one place to another in an orderly fashion in a single line without making noise to avoid disturbance to others. Inform the teachers or school authorities, any know case of indiscipline and unusual happening in the school or while transiting in the bus, immediately.
  - d) A minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory.
  - e) Leave applied for should be a day in advance and through the prescribed form as given in this Almanac.

#### **RECOMMENDATION TO PARENTS / GUARDIANS**

#### PARENTS ARE REQUESTED

- to closely monitor their ward's progress by checking the school Almanac and Planner every day and paying attention to their punctuality, discipline and submission of school assignments.
- to encourage their ward to take a balanced interest in studies, co-curricular activities and sports.
- to inform the school immediately if there is any change in address, telephone numbers and bus route.
- restrict pocket money to minimal. Excessive spending is school should be discouraged.
- to ensure that during their ward's absence from school, work done in the class is made up for.
- to provide a supportive value-based environment to their ward at home.
   Using discretion and parental judgement, keep track of their ward's mental health and emotions.
- to monitor the Internet sites visited by their ward and limit television viewing to appropriate programmes and duration.
- contact school to discuss and decide a plan of action to handle the difficulties (academic as well and behavioural) of their ward and to seek guidance.
- to ensure that their ward appear for all tests as per the schedule given in the Organizer. In case the child is unable to take the examination, prior intimation must be given to the Class Teacher in writing.
- to discourage their ward from taking additional leave before the commencement of examinations.
- to come on Saturdays and meet the Principal/Teachers with a prior appointment.

#### SCHOOL DISCIPLINE AND STUDENTS' WELFARE

- · School is functional for the students from Monday to Saturday.
- Students must carry their Almanac to school every day. Parents should check it regularly.
- All students are expected to reach school before the bell rings.
- A disciplinary action will be taken if the children are repeatedly late to school.
- Students who come to school with their escorts will not be permitted to leave the school with anyone else.
- Students who do not do their homework regularly may be asked to stay back to complete their assignments.
- A sick child should not be sent to school. He/she will not be sent on half days under any circumstances as a safely measure.
- Students are not allowed to go to a relative or friend's house from school.
- Students are to be tidy and neatly dressed in school uniform on all working days and school functions.
- All the text books and exercise books should be neatly covered and property labelled. All the belongings of students must bear their name, class and section.
- No books (other than text books or library books) should be brought to the school.
- The school is not responsible for goods that are lost. It is advisable not to bring any sharp objects and valuable articles like expensive watches, fancy stationery items and items of jewellery etc.
- Mobile phones or any other electronic gadget, if found with the student, will be confiscated.
- · Lending or borrowing of money or other articles is strictly prohibited.
- Care must be taken of all school property. Students should be trained not to damage any school furniture, write or draw anything on the walls.
   Recovery of any damage will be done from the concerned student.
- Students are advised to keep their classrooms/school building/campus neat and clean. Waste material and leftover must be thrown into the dustbins only.
- Students should observe polite civil behaviour. Shouting, building or use of foul language is forbidden.

- Under no pretext should a student miss any teaching/games/activity period. In case a teacher is absent alternate arrangements are made by the time table incharge.
- Change of classroom between periods should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.
- Parents and guardians must not enter the class rooms either to see their wards or to seek an interview with the teachers during school hours.
- Parents and Guardians of all the students should contact the teachers on the PTM days to note the progress of their wards.
- A student who uses unfair means during tests will be given zero in the subject and a warning letter.
- It is mandatory for all children to take school tests. No retest is allowed. You are requested not to send your ward for the test in case of any serious illness. The child will not be sent back after the test. He/She will have to attend full school.
- The school reserves the right to suspend or to take strict disciplinary action against a student whose diligence or progress in studies is constantly satisfactory, or whose conduct is harmful to other students.
- The student indulging in any misbehaviour/misdeed directly or online which could be derogatory for the institution or any person will be taken to task.
- · Office bearers will wear their respective badges daily.
- Students are not allowed to use the school telephone without permission. They will not allowed to answer phone calls during class hours.
- The school has the right to retain the work books, activity books and any other material used by the students in the class.
- Low waist skirts/trousers are not permitted. Strict actions will be taken against uniform defaulters.

The undesirable behaviour / repeated indiscipline will lead to serious consequences even leading to expulsion.

#### **ABSENCE**

- Student's leave has to be approved by the appropriate authority.
- Parents should fill up the "Leave Application" given in the School Almanac, for each day the student is absent from school stating the reason for absence or leave taken. A student who has been absent on the previous day will not be admitted to the class without the same.
- Repeated absence without leave or unexpected absence for more than
  ten consecutive days renders the student liable to have his/her name
  struck off the rolls. Re-admission may be granted only on payment of
  fresh admission fee, provided the vacancy still exists.
- All children are expected to attend school on the opening day after every vacation. It is compulsory for students to complete 75% attendance in the year to make them eligible for the final assessments. In case attendance is short, the students will not be eligible for any academic prize.
- Students returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease must bring a certificate from a doctor.
- Students suffering from any one of the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to the school.

Chicken Pox - Till complete falling of scabs.

Cholera - Till the child is completely well.

Measles - After the rashes disappear.

Mumps - Until the Swelling has gone.

Whooping Cough - Six weeks.

Jaundice - Six weeks.

#### WITHDRAWAL

- If a child has to be withdrawn from school, parents are requested to given one calendar month's notice in writing. However, the fee for the quarter will be charged.
- Transfer Certificate will not be issued untill all dues of the school are settled

#### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

School uniform gives a sense of identity and ensures uniformity among the students. It should be worn with a sense of dignity and pride and should be adhered to by all the students. All students are expected to wear the school uniform as specified during the classes, organized functions, trips etc.

Parents are expected to ensure the their wards are in proper uniform before leaving home.

- Students must wear their Identity Card and belts everyday.
- For all the students, the proper footwear in both summer and winter is black shoes. No shoes of any other colour or kind nor slippers or other forms of high-heeled shoes are permissible. White shoes should be worn for games and Activities only.
- Students must carry a handkerchief and a napkin to school.
- All boys (except Sikhs) must dress their hair short. Girls should tie their hair properly with black bands. Long hair should be plaited neatly. They should not wear fancy hair clips.
- No Gold jewellery is to be worn to school.

#### IN WINTER

- The children are supposed to wear only white inners.
- Tie & Blazer with proper logo are compulsory.

## THE PURPOSE OF EDUCATION

by Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.



Education must train one for quick, resolute and effective thinking. To think incisively and to think for one's self is very difficult. We are prone to let our mental life become invaded by legions of half truths, prejudices, and propaganda. At this point, I often wonder whether or not education is fulfilling its purpose. A great majority of the so-called educated people do not think logically and scientifically. Even the press, the classroom, the platform, and the pulpit in many instances do not give us objective and unbiased truths. To save man from the morass of propaganda, in my opinion, is one of the chief aims of education. Education must enable one to sift and weigh evidence, to discern the true from the false, the real from the unreal, and the facts from the fiction.

The function of education, therefore, is to teach one to think intensively and to think critically. But education which stops with efficiency may prove the greatest menace to society. The most dangerous criminal may be the man gifted with reason, but with no morals.

We must remember that intelligence is not enough. Intelligence plus character—that is the goal of true education. The complete education gives one not only power of concentration, but worthy objectives upon which to concentrate. The broad education will, therefore, transmit to one not only the accumulated knowledge of the race but also the accumulated experience of social living.

If we are not careful, our institution & education will produce a group of close-minded, unscientific, illogical propagandists, consumed with immoral acts. Be careful, "brethren!" Be careful, teachers!


